## Working With People Who May Be Using Alone

As overdoses are one of the biggest concerns we have when working with people who use drugs and in recovery, we wanted to have a conversation about things we could do and inform people about who we think or know are using alone. We will be joined by Beyer Bullard from SafeSpot who will join us to share information and aid us in discussing what we can do as providers to help prevent fatal overdoses for those using alone.

**Beyer Bullard** (he/him): Beyer serves as the Communications and Outreach Specialist for SafeSpot Overdose Prevention Hotline, where he has worked for two years. A graduate of Northeastern University with a degree in Human Services, Beyer coordinates statewide outreach initiatives to expand awareness of SafeSpot services, improve overdose-prevention education and advance a continuum of support that recognizes drug use as a community-wide topic.

**SafeSpot** is an Overdose Prevention Hotline. We operate a 24/7, confidential hotline that connects people using drugs alone with a trained operator who can call for help in case of overdose. SafeSpot is nationwide, peer run and free to use. We are committed to creating a confidential, judgement-free space for people to stay safe when they are using alone.
